Instructions given to NFL for lasting power of attorney
Initial instructions – face to face meeting OR e mail.

2

NFL will confirm your instructions in relation to the terms of your Lasting Powers of Attorney will for your approval and provide Terms of Engagement – we will confirm our charges.

3

Client provides instructions to proceed and approval of terms of the Lasting Powers of Attorney

4

NFL will prepare draft Lasting Powers of Attorney which will be forwarded to you for your approval.

5

Client approves Lasting Powers of Attorney. Arrangements made for signings.

6

Lasting Powers of Attorney signed. NFL will sign Lasting Powers of Attorney as Certificate Provider – the signing appointment must be a face to face appointment.

Arrangements will be made for the Attorneys to sign the LPAS. NFL will send the signed LPAs to the Office of the Public Guardian for registration.

The Office of the Public Guardian are currently taking up to 20 weeks to register LPAs.
